Injury Management and Rehabilitation Policy

Flinders Children's Centre and Tji Tji Wiltja Preschool and DfE are committed to providing a safe and healthy work environment for its staff, students, contractors, volunteers and visitors.

Injury prevention and injury management is of high importance at this site.

OHS&W practices at Kindergarten,

- \cdot Comply with legislative requirements and departmental OHSW and Injury Management policies and procedures
- · Consider injury prevention and management
- · Ensure so far as is practicable that the workplace is in a safe condition
- · Ensure that all staff are appropriately trained including Asthma, Anaphylaxis and First Aid.
- · Inducts all persons coming on-site about OHS&W and injury Management policies and procedures
- · Ensure that accidents/ incidents are reported and investigated
- · Support the injured person in rehabilitation.

Student injuries or illness.

Students who are injured at Flinders Children's Centre and Tji Tji Wiltja Preschool will be attended to by a trained adult. The child will receive

- · Reassurance
- · Injuries will be tended to according to the injury or illness.
- · The child will rest as required.
- · Treatment will be recorded on the first aid log.
- \cdot Parents will be called immediately if necessary or informed at the end of session. (Notification forms are in the First Aid log folder.)
- · If the injury is severe the child will be settled and an ambulance will be called.
- · Parents will be notified.
- · If a parent cannot be contacted and supervision of the other children allows a staff member will travel with the child.
- \cdot Where the child requires medical treatment it will be recorded on the DfE online Injury and Response Management System.
