Playdough Recipe

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup salt
- 1 cup plain flour
- 2 tbs cream of tartar
- 1 cup water
- 1 tbs oil
- 3 drops liquid food colouring

<u>Method</u>

Step 1 - Mix all ingredients together in a medium-sized saucepan.

Step 2 - Stir over heat until dough is pliable.

Step 3 - Allow to cool, and store in a well-sealed plastic bag or container.
