Additionally, this inquiry complements our new community garden initiative, which aims to strengthen our bond with nature and encourage hands-on learning experiences.

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
Community Garden Project
















These fees play a vital role in supporting our nutrition program, ensuring that your children receive healthy snacks and lunches each day.
